mold, green mold and stem-end rot. Mix
15.2 oz. of Freshgard 598 with 110 gal-
lons of water or water wax for a treatment
level of 1,000 ppm thiabendazole. Where
decay potential is high, additional
Freshgard 598 may be added. Do not
exceed 5,000 ppm thiabendazole.

PAPAYAS (postharvest): Stem-end rot.
Mix 15.2 - 30.4 oz. of Freshgard 598 with
110 gallons of water or water wax for a
treatment level of 1,000 to 2,000 ppm thi-
abendazole.

Maintain constant agitation of mixture.
Apply by spraying at a rate of one gallon
per 8,000 - 10,000 pounds of fruit.

BANANAS (postharvest): Crown rot. Mix
15.2 oz. of Freshgard 598 with 560 gal-
lons of water for a treatment level of 500
ppm thiabendazole.

Dip fruit after it has been dehydrated from
the stem and passed through the deleafen-
ing operation. Keep suspension stirred.
