Crabgrass Preventer 3
EPA Registration No. 8780-57
Your Submission Dated June 12, 2003

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that the following revisions are made:

1. The order of the First Aid statements and precautionary statements under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" must correspond with the most severe route of exposure listed first.
2. Delete the phrase, "**or offered to others for their use,**" from the "If partly filled" disposal statement. This phrase is not related to disposal and is misleading to the user, therefore the product could be deemed to be misbranded with such a phrase.

The amended label supersedes all previously accepted labels. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please submit one copy of the final printed label, incorporating the revisions stated above, before you release the product for shipment. Our previous letter on this submission incorrectly stated that the EPA Registration Number for this product was 56819-16. Our records have been corrected to indicate that EPA Reg. No. 8780-57 is the actual registration number for this product. Thank you for bringing this error to our attention.

Preventing the successful germination of Crabgrass (Hairy & Smooth), Yellow Foxtail, Green Foxtail, Goosegrass, and Barnyardgrass.
Fertilizing the lawn.

WHERE TO USE

Use only on the established grass for all residential turf areas; not for use on pasture or hay. Do not use on newly seeded areas, seed beds, edible crop areas, bentgrass putting greens, or dichondra turf.

WHEN TO USE

Apply in the Spring before May 15th, but not later than the drop of Forsythia blossoms. Do not apply when wind conditions would cause drift from areas being treated. Wait 60 days before doing any reseeding in the treated areas.

HOW TO USE

Rake lawn if necessary to remove extraneous material. DO NOT rake or disturb the soil surface after application. Spread evenly over the lawn with a good fertilizer spreader. The settings given in the table are only approximate; due to variations in the performance of individual machines and differences in the walking speed of applicators. Check your own spreader. THE CORRECT USE RATE FOR THIS PRODUCT IS 4.0 LBS. PER 1000 SQUARE FEET.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
