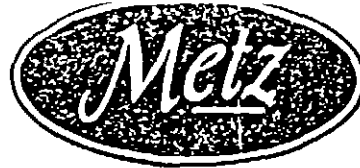

Dilute this sodium hypochlorite solution to 900 ppm available chlorine. Add to a hypochlorinator (metering distribution system, as detailed in the National Sanitation Foundation's "Check water frequency." *Contact your local Health Department.

DIRECTIONS FOR

For a new pool or for spring (16 flu. oz.) of this solution per 10,000 gallons of water. This dosage is by weight.

For Pool Maintenance:

A) Adjust pool water pH

B) Add manually or by automatic at a rate to maintain 1.0 ppm. One-half pint solution for each 6000 gallons of water. Available chlorine by weight 1.0 ppm available chlorine per swimmer. Use to residual are in the product.
