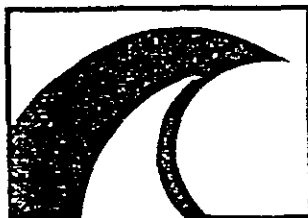

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazard to Human and Domestic Animals

### DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. ## DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN SWIMMING POOLS:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Dose: add 1 gallon ECONOCIDE PLUS swimming pool algacide to 50,000 gallons of pool water.

Maintenance Dose: add 1 quart ECONOCIDE PLUS swimming pool algacide to 50,000 gallons of pool water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If make-up water is added to the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of ECONOCIDE PLUS for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week.

When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of ECONOCIDE PLUS to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

When ECONOCIDE PLUS is used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of Chlorocytis pyrenoidosa (green), Phormidium lunatum, Phormidium rotii.

Lyngha venicolar (blue-green) and other swimming pool algae. ECONOCIDE PLUS is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other water-treating chemicals. ECONOCIDE PLUS works best when added by itself directly to pool water. ECONOCIDE PLUS at use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

## DIRECTIONS FOR SPAS/WHIRLPOOLS

Initial Dose: Add 12.5 ounces of Econocide PLUS to 5,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dose: Add 3.2 ounces of Econocide PLUS to 5,000 gallons of water at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

Drain and clean Spa/Whirlpool/Hot Tub depending upon bather load.

## STORAGE

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER SUPPLY.

DISPOSAL: Store in a dry place not to exceed 120°F.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container with water. Return metal drums and dispose of in a sanitary landfill and local authorities. Plastic containers may be recycled, if allowed by local authorities.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide disposal of excess pesticide, sprays, etc. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by other means, contact your State Pesticide or Hazardous Waste representative for guidance.
