




#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

E-Z CLOR\* TRICHLOR 80 LARGE TABS help prevent growth of algae, bacteria and fungi in swimming pools. Place tablet in plastic skimmer basket. Avoid metal objects.

- 1. Before using E-Z Clor Trichlor 80 Large Tabs for the first time, pool water should be stabilized with E-Z Clor Save chlorine stabilizer. Follow directions on the label for that product. Stabilizer increases the effective life of chlorine by reducing loss caused by the sun's rays.
