DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR ANNUAL GRASSES AND WEEDS Apply 60 to 120 gallons per acre.

FOR PERENNIAL GRASSES AND WEEDS Apply 120 to 200 gallons per acre.

APPLICATION

Apply with any on or off track equipment that will accurately apply uniform coverage over the area to be treated. Low pressure sprayers that permit the application of substantially large volume at minimum pressure are preferable due to lesser chance of drift. Best time of treatment is when weeds are small.
