- j. Include a disposal heading to read:

Storage and Disposal

- k. Delete the sanitization claim. Your formulation is not cleared for this use.
 - l. On the right panel, revise ". . . in controlling the hazard of cross-infection" to read ". . . in controlling the hazard of cross-contamination."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

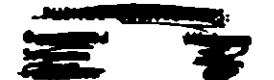
