

HOUSEHOLD BLEACH

A SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE SOLUTION NO LIME OR ACID IN THIS SOLUTION DIRECTIONS

Use on White and Fast Colors only. DO NOT USE ON SILK OR WOOL.

FOR LAUNDERING — Use 1/8 cup of Bleach for each gallon of water in machine.

IN SOAKING SUDS—Use one tablespoonful of Bleach to each gallon of water. Add soap and washing powder; soak white cottons or linens one-half hour or overnight.

FIRST RINSE—One tablespoonful to each gallon rinse water. USE FOR BABIES' DAINTY COTTONS AND LINENS, RUBBER GARMENTS, BED PROTECTORS, DIAPERS AND RUBBER SHEETS.

FOR STAINS—To remove stains, such as fruit, ink, medicine, berry, grass, blood, coffee and other stubborn stains from cotton or linens—thoroughly mix 3 tablespoonfuls of Bleach in a quart of cold water, soak 10 to 15 minutes, rinse well. Brown spots, which are sometimes left after removing ink stains, can usually be removed with lemon juice or vinegar.

SCORCH and MILDEW STAINS—To remove scorch and mildew stains from white cottons and linens—thoroughly mix 3 tablespoonfuls of Bleach to each quart of cold water; soak 10 to 15 minutes, rinse well and hang in sunlight until all traces disappear.

CAUTION — IRRITANT

Contains sodium hypochlorite. Avoid contact with eyes and other mucous membranes. In case of contact with eyes, flush thoroughly with water. If swallowed, give one or two glasses of water or milk, call physician.
