## CAUTION

## KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DIKECTIONS: Dilute as directed. Do not mix with other cleaners.

For general cleaning, and sanitizing: of walls, floors, tables, refrigerators, stoves, sinks, bathroom fixtures, food utensils and garbage cans: Wash with solution containing one ounce UNISAN per gallon of water.

Disinfection in hospitals: For disinfection of walls, floors and other nonporous surfaces, after cleaning, use one ounce of UNISAN in one gallon of water. For disinfection of porous and heavily contaminated surfaces, use two ounces of UNISAN to one gallon of water.

To clean and disinfect combs, brushes, razors, scissors, rubber goods, etc.: Wipe articles clean and soak for ten minutes in a solution containing one tablespoonful of UNISAN per quart of water.

To clean and sanitize animal and bird cages, Kennels, barns, etc.: Wash with solution containing one ounce of UNISAN per gallon of water.
