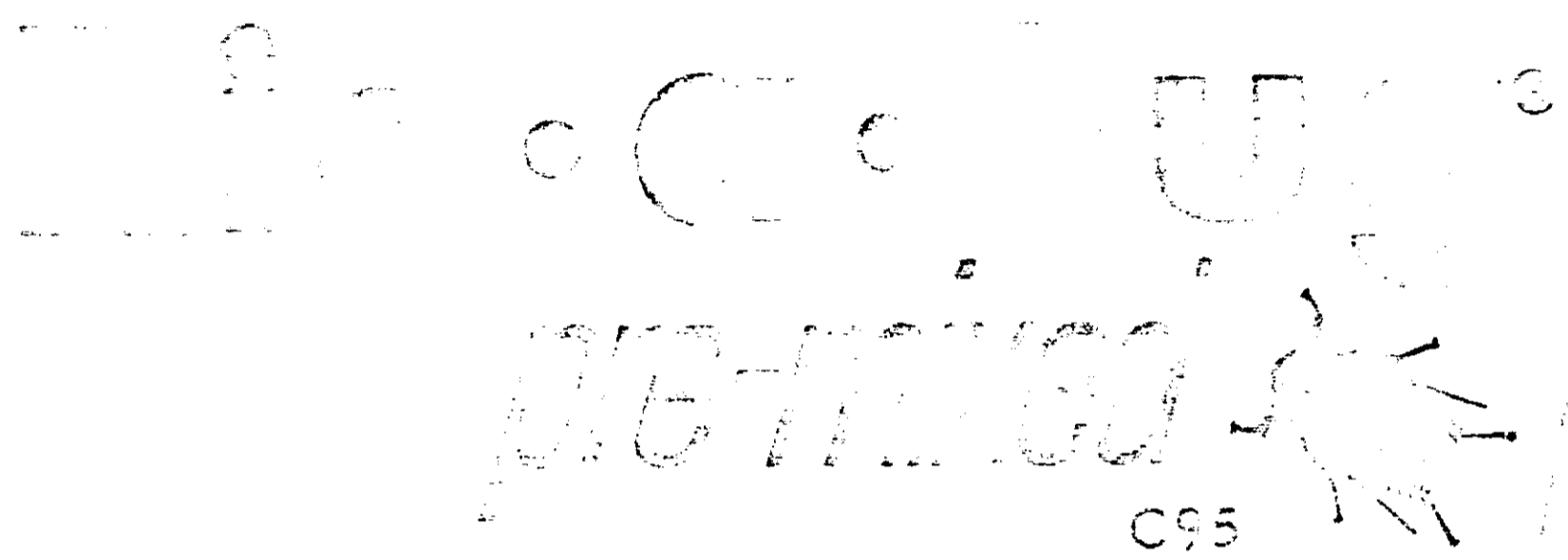

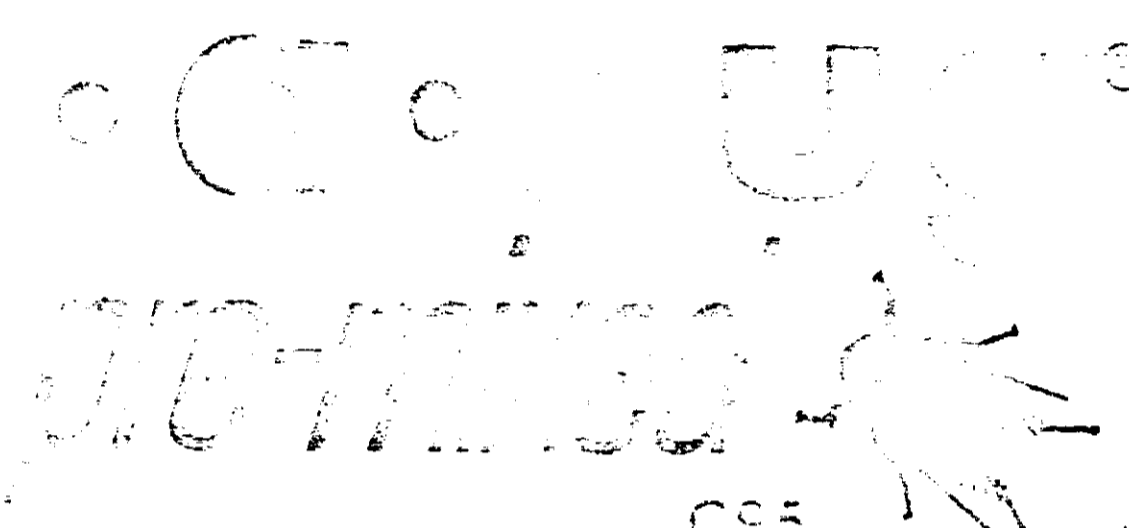

This is a liquid that kills cockroaches on contact. It is used in areas where cockroaches are known to be present. The fourth step is to use a cockroach dust. This is a powder that kills cockroaches on contact. It is used in areas where cockroaches are known to be present. The fifth step is to use a cockroach fogger. This is a gas that kills cockroaches in a room. It is used in areas where cockroaches are known to be present.

Use Rid-A-Bug Household Insecticide as a spot treatment to control cockroaches, silverfish, spiders and other pests mentioned below. Apply as a coarse (large droplet) spray to localized areas where pests may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Re-treat as needed.

Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window sills and frames; behind and beneath stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may occur.

Brown Dog Ticks: To control these pests, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, and behind baseboards, window and door frames and floor and areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. If you have a pet, should be removed and inspected for ticks, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not apply pet to this product.

Flea and Mosquito Larvae: To control these pests, apply as a spot treatment to areas where they are found or may occur. Spray outdoors, such as lawns, and other areas where they may be found.
