Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on Skin:** Wash contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

This product is a highly effective insecticide for flying insects. It gives fast knockdown to flying or crawling insects.

For best results, place quantity of HOT SHOT FLY AND MOSQUITO INSECT KILLER into a good clean metal sprayer which produces a fine mist (such as Hot Shot metal spray gun) and spray in accordance with the following directions. When used in an enclosed area, do not remain in treated area and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Flying Moths: Close doors and windows. Spray freely toward ceiling in all directions. Spray directly on as many insects as possible. Leave room closed 10 to 15 minutes. Repeat as needed.

To Kill Roaches and Water Bugs: Spray thoroughly on infested area and directly on as many insects as possible. Spray areas where these pests enter the premises. Spray top surfaces and undersides of carpets and rugs.

For Outdoor Use: Spray in the general area of outdoor activities, on chairs, tables, ground and in surrounding air to reduce annoyance from insects. Repeat frequently.
