The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- 1. Delete "Resmethrin" from the ingredients statement and add the chemical name for Sumithrin in its place.
- 2. In the Environmental Hazards statement, after "(swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes)," add "Cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes must be done in a manner that avoids contamination of bodies of water or wetlands."
- 3. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants" or submit an application to USDA requesting these areas. If granted you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.
- 4. In the directions for Carpet Beetles, add "Allow treated areas to thoroughly dry before occupying."
