**Statement of Practical Treatment**

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on Skin: Wash contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**INDOORS: To kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for an average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

**To kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room. Pay special attention to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and food storage areas. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry.

**To kill Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever insects are suspected.

**To kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders:** Spray as many insects as possible. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

**To kill Fleas and Ticks around pet areas:** Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping areas of pets around baseboards, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick product registered for application directly on pets before allowing them to reenter treated area.

**OUTDOORS: To reduce and kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Moths:** Spray area infested with slow sweeping motion 3 inches from shrubs, bushes, trees. Spray with slow sweeping motion 3 seconds per cubic yard of space away from the treated area. To kill these pests, treat open areas in a similar manner. Spray only when necessary. Allow spray to dissipate before reentering treated area.

**To kill Ornamental Plant Pests:** General - When sprayed directly on plants will kill the insects listed on the label. When spraying new tender plants, when spraying, hold nozzle 12 inches from plant. For best results, spray on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Spray rows at the second. For heavy growth, spray on the first. Do not spray when temperature is above 85°F. **Eastern Tent Caterpillars, A Leafhoppers, Lacebugs, Weevils, Japanese Beetles, Mealybugs and Box Elder Bugs.** Spray on Spirea, Rose, Crepe Myrtle, Camellia, Azalea, Chrysantheum, Peony, Oleander and Arborvitae.
