The labeling submitted in response to the Registration Standard for Sumithrin is acceptable subject to the comment listed below.

- Change the precautionary statements:

Do not apply directly to or around food. Cover or remove any food utensils and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After space spraying in areas where food is handled, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled with potable water.

to read:

All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

The Confidential Statement of Formula for the alternate formulation is acceptable and has been placed into the file for this product.

If in Eye: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
