PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. **If on Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air.

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before use. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts. For household use only.

INDOORS: To kill Fleas, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for an average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room. Pay special attention to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and food storage areas. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry.

To kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever insects are suspected.

To kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Spray as many insects as possible. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To kill Fleas and Ticks around pet areas: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping areas of pets around baseboards, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick product registered for application directly on pets before allowing them to reenter treated area.

OUTDOORS: To reduce annoyance of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Spray area infested. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray with slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated area. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area.

To kill Ornamental Plant Pests listed below: General - When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants. When spraying, hold can 18-24 inches from plant. For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.

For Eastern Tent Caterpillars, Aphids, Cankerworms, Leafhoppers, Lacebugs, Whiteflies, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Mealybugs, Ants, Caterpillars and Box Elder Bugs. Spray Ornamental Cherry, Spirea, Rose, Crepe Myrtle, Ornamental Crabapple, Andromeda, Azalea, Chrysanthemum, Gardenia, Peony, Oleander and Arborvitae.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool place away from heat, direct sunlight, or open flame. **Disposal:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
