The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Three (3) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

1. The term "New" may be used for a period of one year from the date of this letter.
2. In the section of the product label which begins "To reduce annoyance of Houseflies....", include, or reinstate, the application rate (1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard). Also, delete the following text: ...or any breeze and allow fog to drift over the area.
3. In the section of the product label which begins "To kill Ornamental Plant pests....", include a rate of product application (i.e. 1 foot per second).
4. In the section of the product label titled OPTIONAL DIRECTIONS AND CLAIMS FOR AN OUTDOOR FOGGER, include an application rate of this pesticide product. Also, delete the following text:
 - a. or breeze is slight.
 - b. On windy days, spray with wind.
 - c. Spray with breeze and allow fog to drift over area.



CRAWLING INSECTS

Spray directly on ants, centipedes, sowbugs, and spiders. Spray legs of chairs and tables to repel crawling insects. Treat around patios, yards, outdoor living areas and garbage cans infested by these pests. Also thoroughly spray ant hills for best results.

PRECAUTIONS: People and pets should not be allowed in treated areas until spray has dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture container.
