The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The words ACTIVE INGREDIENTS and INERT INGREDIENTS must be printed in type of the same size and be given equal prominence.
2. Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, revise the statements "Do not apply directly to or around food . . . handled with potable water" and place these precautions under the Directions for Use:

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Nonfood/nonfeed areas of food/feed establishments are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

3. Please provide the flashpoint of the product with the propellant on the Confidential Statement of Formula. The Agency is currently reevaluating the product chemistry guidelines and expects to revise this data requirement in the near future. In the interim, however, the Agency is evaluating the text of flammability statements on a case-by-case basis. Due to the presence of highly flammable components in this product, the Agency is recommending the Physical/Chemical Hazards paragraph below:

Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure.
Keep away from fire, sparks and heated surfaces.
Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 °F may cause bursting.

4. Delete the phrase "With PYRETHROIDS for Fast Knockdown-Quick Kill." Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable.
5. Under Directions for Use for ANIMAL PESTS control, add the following statement:

Allow treated areas to dry thoroughly before pet use.

6. Add the following statement under the subheading **Environmental Hazards:**

Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION
Hazards to humans and Domestic Animals
Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds, and livestock animals before spraying. Do not apply directly to or around food. Cover or remove any food utensils and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is in progress. After spraying, spray in areas where food is handled, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. when exposed food will be handled with potable water. Do not use around children.

Statement of Practical Treatment
If Swallowed: Get a physician or pharmacist for immediate help. Drink 1-2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by forcing back of throat with finger until you feel sick again. Never give anything to a person anything by mouth by any means. **If on Skin:** Wash immediately with soap and plenty of water. If on face, wash with plenty of water. **If in Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water. **If inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if needed.

Environmental Hazards - This pesticide is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or wells, or swamps, etc. (including bird potholes). Do not allow it to run to water. It may be hazardous to fish and to aquatic organisms in a fresh water.

Physical and Chemical Hazards - Contains under pressure. Do not use in hot or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Exposure to high temperatures above 120°F may cause bursting.

Storage and Disposal - Storage: Store in a cool place away from heat, do not store in open flame. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area. Disposal: Empty container into a sealed container in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

Directions for Use - This is a use of the label. Do not use this product in a manner not consistent with its labeling. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. REMOVE PROTECTIVE CAP. AIM SPRAY OPENING AWAY FROM PERSON. PUSH BUTTON TO SPRAY.**
