**INDOOR PLANTS:** African Violets, Begonias, Chinese Evergreen, Coleus, Dieffenbachia, Fatsyhedera, Ferns, Ficus, Ivy, Philodendron, Schefflera, Umbrella Plant, Wandering Jew.

**OUTDOOR PLANTS:** Ageratum, Althea, Andromeda, Arborvitae, Broad Leaf Acacia, Cherry, Chrysanthemum, Crab Apple, Crape Myrtle, Daisy, Daphne, Dogwood, Euonymus, Forsythia, Gardenia, Geranium, Iris, Ivy, Locust, Maple, Marigolds, Mimosa, Nasturtium, Oaks, Oleander, Palms, Peonies, Perperonia, Pines, Purple Passion Vine, Queen Sago, Rhododendron, Snapdragon, Spruce, Spirea, Tobira, Toyon, Viburnum, Wisteria, Zinnia. Use lightly on Azaleas, Junipers, Roses, Flowering quince, Ash and Camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under heavy use. Also use cautiously on young plants and on new growth.

**FOR INDOOR PLANTS:** Spray both upper and lower surface of leaves from a distance of 12-14 inches until visibly wet. Repeat as needed.

**FOR OUTDOOR PLANTS:** For best results spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Avoid using in hot, bright sunshine. Use slow sweeping motion, holding the dispenser approximately one foot from foliage. Spray both upper and lower leaf surfaces until visibly wet. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
