PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not apply directly to or around food. Cover or remove any food utensils and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in areas where food is handled, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled with potable water.

Statement of Practical Treatment:

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Drink plenty of water. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on Skin:** Wash contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish and to aquatic organisms in adjacent waters.

Physical and Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Storage and Disposal - Storage: Store in a cool place away from heat, direct sunlight, or open flame. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area. **Disposal:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
