The labeling for the product referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records subject to the comments listed below.

1. In the product name the term "Exterminator" must be deleted as it is too broad and promising.
2. The formula dated September 4, 1990 is acceptable and replaces the previously approved statements under this registration. Ensure that the label ingredient declaration for each active represents its actual content (the lower certified limit for d-trans allethrin and chlorpyrifos do not meet the label guarantee). Have your supplier of Belle Aire # 1008 furnish the complete composition of the fragrance, cite this product by name and registration number.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not apply directly to or around food. Cover or remove any food utensils and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on Skin:** Wash contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** This product may cause cholinesterase inhibition. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM may be effective as an adjunct to atropine.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish and to aquatic organisms in adjacent waters.

Physical and Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Directions for Use

Do not apply in a slow, sweeping motion. Apply 12 inches from treated surface. Repeat every 100 seconds for every 100 square feet underneath upholstered cushions, in closets and other areas not seen or suspected. Do not remove portions of upholstered furniture. Avoid wetting of upholstered furniture. Do not return for one hour before allowing to walk on treated surface. Ventilate room thoroughly. Do not use cleaning results put off cleaning detergents or cleansers. Do not use, however, will not affect. **To Kill Fleas and Ticks on Pets:** destroy old pet bedding. Vacuum around baseboards, walls, and corners. Do not spray animals. Do not use after spray has dried.
