The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with a registration under the Federal Insecticide, Furgicide, and Rodenticide Act. is acceptable provided the following revision. s made prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling:

or drinking on treated areas may be killed." add "Do not exceed maximum permitted label rates. Application rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds and waterfowl.". The Agency understands that you have not included the migratory waterfowl precaution that pertains to use in Nassau County, New York, because this product is marketed only in AL, AK, FL, GA, LA, MS, NM, NC, OK, SC, TN & TX the "fire ant states". If in the future this product is marketed in New York (assuming such a northern spread of the target pest), then that migratory waterfowl precaution would have to be added to the label.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please submit rive (5) copies of the revised amended label prior to release for shipment under the amended label. Please refer to the Diazinon Registration Standard, as amended, for release for shipment and channels of trade dates for diazinom products bearing appropriately amended labels.
