Subject: Amendment- clarify label  
Spectracide Fire Ant Killer  
EPA Registration Number 8845-101  
Your submission dated March 7, 1995

This amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Add the front panel limitation "For outdoor use on home lawns and other outdoor home recreation areas only. Use on outside areas other than around the home would require this to be a Restricted Use product which the Agency does not believe is your intent. Also revise "Spectracide is ideal for use in lawns and other recreational areas" to "Spectracide is ideal for use on home lawns and other outdoor home recreation areas only.".

b. Revise Active Ingredients to Active Ingredient since there is only one.

c. Add "get medical attention" to the end of the If on skin advice in the Statement of Practical Treatment.

d. Add a comma after "especially waterfowl" in the second sentence of the Environmental Hazards.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. (graphic) Sprinkle 1/2 cup granules over and 2 feet around each mound.
2. (graphic) Immediately after applying, GENTLY water in granules using at least 1 gallon of water for each mound.
3. Treat new mounds as they appear.
4. For spot treatment of ants, other than fire ants: Apply 1 - 1 1/2 teaspoons over and around each ant hill.

#### USE TIPS

1. (graphic) For best results, apply in morning or evening hours. At these times, fire ants are closer to the surface virtually assuring the product will contact them.
2. Gentle application of water is important as high pressure spray may disturb ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Reclose bag lightly after each use. Store in a cool, dry area which is inaccessible to children and pets. Do not reuse empty bag. Discard bag in trash.
