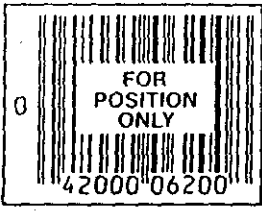
Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

TO KILL ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS and EARWIGS: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES and DERMESTIDS: Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.
