
Dear Mr. LaRocca:

Enclosed please find our Notification to add the marketing phrase "*Country Breeze/Scent/Perfume*" to the label for the subject product. This is a variation on two phrases on our current accepted label: "*Country potpourri/Scent/Perfume*" and "*Floral Breeze/Scent/Perfume*", which are for use with the alternate formula containing fragrance. We would also like to add "*Unscented*" for use with the basic formula without fragrance. Finally, we are taking this opportunity to add the statement concerning ozone depleting chemicals, "*Contains no CFCs or other ozone depleting substances. Federal regulations prohibit CFC propellants in aerosols.*", to our current approved label per P.R. Notice 92-2.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notices 92-2 and 95-2 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 95-2 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

I have enclosed a copy of the label with the additions highlighted, five "clean" copies of the revised label, the latest EPA stamped label and comment letter dated July 29, 1993, and a subsequent Notification dated August 23, 1994 for your reference.
