

House mice consume a lethal dose in a single feeding with dead rodents appearing one to two days after bait consumption. Rodents cease feeding after consuming a lethal dose in a single-night's feeding. Sudden Death is effective against anticoagulant-resistant mice.

DO NOT OPEN PLACE PACKS, MICE WILL EAT THROUGH

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT EXPOSE CHILDREN, PETS, OR OTHER NONTARGET ANIMALS TO RODENTICIDES. TO HELP TO PREVENT ACCIDENTS:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Selection of Treatment Areas:

Baiting Strategy:

Highest bait consumption occur on the first day or two after treatment. Inspect the placements and replenish bait as needed. In the event of evidence of heavy feeding. Although bait usually provide a lethal dose, maintain bait stations to provide all rodents a chance to feed or bait stations be continued until all signs of feeding have stopped. A continuous source of infestation is present. Replenish bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
