Please find enclosed notification per PR Notice 98-10 to add a 20-count size to the labeling. In your email to Bill Metzger, dated 2/27/07, you indicated that this change would not require a change in use directions and therefore would be appropriate to submit to the Agency via notification. A copy of this email is enclosed for your reference.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

Many times changes in directions are needed, especially for anticoagulants in packages sizes less than 1 lb. We currently hold a registration (8845-127) for a Rat and Mouse product.

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This uses 0.75 ounce packets and the Net Wt. statement indicates , "Contains 8, 10, 12 or 24 packets". If we want to have a 20 packet package, can we just make that change as we are allowed on other pesticide products?

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PR Notice 98-10 is not clear. It seems to indicate that changes in Net Wt on a rodenticide is not notifiable. Can you clarify?

- 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.

Selection of Treatment Areas: Determine areas where mice and rats will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along the walls, by

gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where mice or rats or their signs have been observed. Remove as much food accessible to mice and rats as possible.

Application Directions: Sudden Death[™] does not contain an anticoagulant rodenticide. Generally, mice and rats will consume a lethal dose in a single feeding with death occurring one or more days later.

HOUSE MICE: Apply one placepack per location. Two unopened placepacks may be needed at points of extremely high mouse activity. Space placements 8 to 12 feet apart in areas where mice are active.

NORWAY & ROOF RATS: Apply 2 to 8 unopened placepacks per location. Adjust the number of placepacks used according to the level of rat feeding expected at each location. Space placements 15 to 30 feet apart in areas where rats are active.

Baiting Strategy: Highest bait consumption is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect the placements and replenish bait at sites where there is heavy feeding or where there is evidence of heavy feeding. Although one nights feeding will usually provide a lethal dose, maintain bait for at least a week to provide all of the mice or rats a chance to feed on the bait. Baiting should continue until all signs of feeding have ceased. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed. Collect and properly dispose of all dead mice or rats and leftover bait.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal. If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled**: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
