- B. On the placepack labeling, in the black-blocked section, replace "Do not open placepack in this box" with "Do not open placepack."
  - C. On the placepack labeling under "DIRECTIONS FOR USE." after STOP. READ THIS LABEL., replace the word "box" with "bait station box" (this appears two times in this section). Also, in the second sentence replace the word "bag" with "placepack."
  - D. On both the bait station box and placepack labeling, under "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" add a "." at the end of the last sentence.
3. Submit two copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If the above specified conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT OUTDOORS. This product may be used to control house mice in homes, industrial, and agricultural buildings. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

**Selection of Treatment Areas:** Place bait station along walls, in corners, and in concealed places where mice are active and where non-target mammals and birds will not be exposed to the bait.

Replace units as their contents are consumed. Units not touched after three days should be moved to new locations, consistent with those permitted by this label, if mouse activity persists. Collect and properly dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait and bait stations.
