Remove protective cap. Hold can upright with valve pointed away from face.

For flies, mosquitoes and certain other flying insects: Spray upwards into four corners of closed room for flying insects about 15 or 20 seconds for average rooms. Close windows and doors for about 15 minutes after treatment.

For roaches, ants, silverfish and certain other crawling insects: Spray liberally into cracks of woodwork, voids, holes, hiding and breeding places; directly on insects when possible. Repeat when necessary. Cover cooking utensils, dishes and food before spraying.

For ants: Treat ant trails and areas where these nests enter the premises such as door sills and window frames.

For use in food processing plants, foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before use. When used as a space spray, apply only when plant is not in operation.

Do not puncture or dispose of can after in fire. Store at room temperature (not over 120 degrees F.). Do not spray on food and food surfaces. Do not spray directly on painted surfaces.

Do not reenter treated areas until after the odor of treatment has dissipated.

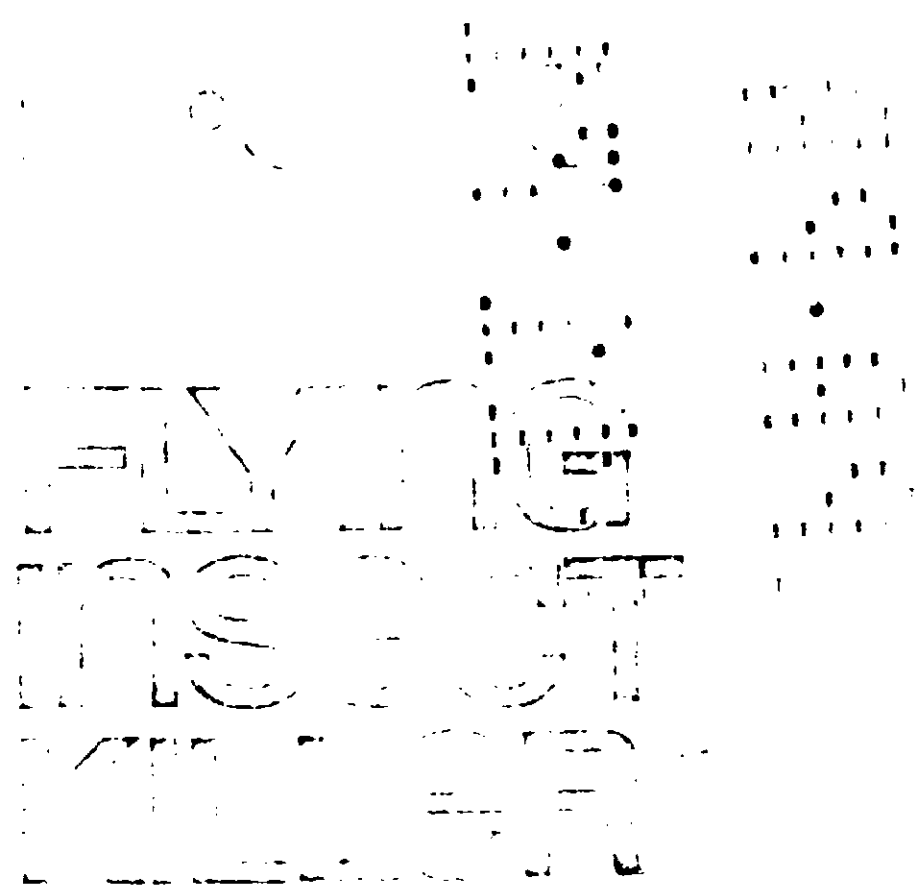
