SAFEGUARD Brand Household Insect Killer may be used anywhere in the home, but food and food utensils should be protected from contamination.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS
Close doors and windows and turn off fans and air conditioners. Cover exposed foods, utensils, and food handling surfaces. Open cabinets and doors to expose spaces to be treated. Extinguish all flames except pilot lights and release can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights. For best results leave treated space undisturbed for 1-2 hours or more. After treatment, open doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes.

AS A TOTAL RELEASE AEROSOL
To kill **Beetles, Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Flying Moths, etc.** - Swing nozzle upright and away from yourself, spray and until engine's fan of valve mounting dial valve will register in open position for total release of contents. Place in upright position on a stand or table. Place paper under can to protect surface immediately around areas of release. Release the contents of this can for each 10,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space; use additional units for remote areas, or where free flow of air is not assured.

AS AN AEROSOL INSECTICIDE
To kill **Flies** (including DDT-resistant strains) **Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Flying Moths, etc.** Use as above and allow 2-3 hours for total coverage to be obtained. Do not spray directly at flying insects. Insects will die within 24 hours, although it may take 48 hours and wasps die after the above dosage.

To kill **Earwigs, Ants, Silverfish, Waterbugs, Spiders, Centipedes, etc.** - Spray directly on insects. Do not spray on walls, ceiling, or floor. Do not spray on plants or animals.

To kill **Bedbugs** - Spray mattresses, springs and bed frames, floor boards, nailings and baseboards. Repeat as necessary.

To kill **Fleas** - Spray floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat as necessary.
