SAFEGUARD Brand Household Insect Killer may be used anywhere in the home, but food and food utensils should be protected from contamination. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Close doors and windows and turn off fans and air conditioners. Cover exposed foods, utensils, and food handling surfaces. Open cabinets and doors to expose spaces to be treated. Extinguish all flames, except pilot lights and release can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights. For best results leave treated space undisturbed for two hours or more. Do not remain in treated areas. After treatment open doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes. If operated manually, do not use as a total release aerosol.

AS A TOTAL RELEASE AEROSOL

To Kill Roaches, Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Small Flying Moths: Holding container upright and away from you, tilt sprayhead until tip engages rim of valve mounting cap. Valve will remain in open position for total release of contents. Place in upright position on a stand or table. Place paper under can to protect surface immediately around areas of release. Release the contents of this can for each 6000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Use additional units for remote areas or where free flow of fog is not assured.

AS AN AEROSOL INSECTICIDE

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Small Flying Moths: If operated manually, do not use as a total release aerosol. Close all doors and windows. Spray about 5-10 minutes for average room. It is not essential to hit flying insects; the airborne mist will kill insects as they fly through it. For hornets and wasps, double the above dosage. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To Kill Roaches, Ants, Silverfish, Waterbugs, Spiders: Spray hidden places such as baseboards, crevices, openings around sinks and pipes, under cabinets and refrigerators. To kill ants, treat doors around window frames and ant trails. Spray directly on bugs when possible. Repeat as needed.

To Kill Bedbugs: Dismantle bed and spray mattresses, springs, and bed frames, floorboards, moldings and baseboards. Spray directly on pests and repeat application as necessary for best results.

To Kill Fleas: Liberally spray floor coverings, cracks and crevices, sleeping quarters of animals, infested furniture and other areas where pests may harbour. Repeat applications may be necessary to insure contact with all pests.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use in stove or heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F may cause bursting. Keep out of reach of children.
