DIRECTIONS FOR USE
 AS A TOTAL RELEASE PRESSURIZED SPRAY AND INDOOR FOGGER
 To Kill: Beetles, Cockroaches, Spiders, Firebrats, Silverfish, Fleas, Mosquitoes, Flies, Ticks, and Ants, and also in the control of Roaches and Waterbugs.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS
 Cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, and food handling equipment and surfaces. Open closets and doors to expose areas. Do not treat furnaces, stoves, and air conditioning units. Do not use in bedrooms and bathrooms. Close all doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes. When fogging, use one unit for each 600 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not re-enter the area during treatment. Leave room at opening of valve and keep the area treated. Close for four hours before entering and airing out. After this treatment, open doors and windows and allow to air out for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks if necessary.

TO OPERATE VALVE
 To lock valve in total release position, hold container upright away from you and point valve opening away from face and eyes. Press valve button all the way down until it locks into and catches on bottom of rim. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve opened open. Holding several sheets of newspaper under can follow directions in above paragraph.

AS A PRESSURIZED SPRAY FOR SPOT TREATMENT
 To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Weevils, Gnats, Houseflies, Hornets and Bees: If operated manually, do not use as a total release device. Close all doors and windows. Spray about 5-10 seconds per average room. It is not essential to hit flying insects; the airborne mist will hit insects as they fly through it. For hornets and bees, double the above dosage. Sweep up and destroy larvae insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.
 To Kill Ants, Silverfish, Firebrats, Spiders, Centipedes and Crickets and also in the control of Roaches and Waterbugs: Spray hidden places such as baseboards, crevices, openings around sinks and pipes, under cabinets and refrigerators. To kill ants, treat doors around window frames and door trims. Spray directly on bugs when possible. Repeat as needed.
 To Kill Ticks: Liberally spray floor coverings, cracks and crevices, sleeping quarters of animals, infested furniture and other areas where pests may harbour. Repeat applications may be necessary to insure contact with all pests.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid use of fogger in areas where children play. Do not use in case of contact with skin. Wash with plenty of water.
 Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas, in the home, or in processing, storage, and distribution areas. Do not use during treatment of thorough cleaning before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
