Keep can upright when spot treating. Do not hold can sideways or upside down.

Remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright, point valve opening away from face and about 8-10 inches from surface being treated. Aim nozzle, press plastic button to release and spray. Spray until moist, do not soak. Repeat as necessary. Windows and doors may be left open while spraying. Allow treated surfaces to dry before permitting people or pets to return to treated areas. Infirm residents or patients must be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate rooms for 2 hours before returning patients. Do not spray food/feed humans or pets. Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible product areas of food processing plants. Bedbugs: Spray upholstered furniture in tufts, and especially under and around seams and ends of fabric. Take bed apart. Spray mattress seams, bedsprings, bed frame and joints. Spray floor, rugs, floorboards, moldings, baseboards and furniture legs. Thoroughly air premises and permit treatment to dry before using.

Fleas: Spray floors, floor coverings and other places infested by fleas. Spray sleeping quarters of animals or pets, and change bedding after spraying. Do not use on animals or pets. Allow treated surfaces to dry before permitting pets to return to treated areas.
