Dear Ms. LaRocco:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Replace Precautionary Statements with the following:
 - "Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals."
- 2. Under the Directions for Use, after the sentence "Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishment, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed.", add, "served".
- 3. Under the Ingredients Statement, replace "Inert Ingredients" with "Other Ingredients".

- 4. Either delete all "Repeat as necessary", statements or indicate the repeat interval which should be based upon the residual effectiveness of the product.
- 5. Delete "Not for Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants." The statement, Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments etc" already covers this restriction.



BLACK JACK JET ACTION CRAWLING INSECT



Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing, in case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. ANTS, LONE STAR TICKS, DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, FLEAS. Apply theroughly to intestation bushes, grass or weeds. For ants, spray freely around ant trails and hills
