Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Environmental Hazards

This product is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain do not blow or wash pesticide away from the treatment area.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat spark, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed.

Not For Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants. Remove protective cap, hold container upright and direct spray away from face. Hold can 12-15 inches from surface being sprayed, press valve down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 4 ounces product to treat approximately 25 square feet of surface area).

Indoors

Ants: Spray freely around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter premise. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Ants, Booklice, Boxelder Bugs, Centerpedes, Cockroaches (including adult and immature stages of both non-resistant, organophosphate and carbonate resistant strains), Crickets, Dermestides, Firebrats, Fleas, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Ticks and Waterbugs: Apply thoroughly to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, and hidden areas around sinks and storage areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases and similar areas. When pests are driven out, spray directly. Repeat as necessary.

Outdoors

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can at a slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

Crawling Insects:

Ants, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, and Silverfish: Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for bed control.

Ants, Crickets, Dog Ticks, and Lone Star Ticks,: Apply thoroughly to infested areas of bushes, grass or weeds. For ants, spray freely around ant trails and hills.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area away from children.

Container Disposal: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available, **if partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
