The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the permethrin RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

[CAUTION:] Thoroughly wash with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Environmental Hazards

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or runoff into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide from the treated area. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are foraging the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Restrictions

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before surface applications. Do not use on humans or pets. Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter treated area until sprays have dried. Not for broadcast use on indoor residential surfaces. Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter, where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems. All outdoor applications must be limited to only spot or crack-and-crevice treatments, except for the following permitted uses: 1) treatment to soil or vegetation around structures; 2) applications to lawns, turf and other vegetation; and 3) applications to building foundations up to a maximum height of 3 feet. Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors and eaves) are limited to only spot and crack-and-crevice applications.

Shake Well Before Using

Read Entire Label Before Each Use

Remove cap, affix trigger, pump or other type sprayer to container for application. Do not transfer product to another container.

Indoor Application

Only for spot application; do not use as a space spray indoors. Do not apply to classrooms while in use. In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food/feed.

Surface Spraying

For 60-day [2-months] Control of Ants, Cadelles, Centipedes, Cheese Mites, Clover Mites, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Drugstore Beetles, Firebrats, Grain Mites, Granary Weevils, Meal Worms, Millipedes, Palmetto Bugs, Pillbugs, Rice Weevils, Rust Red Flour Beetles, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Waterbugs: Direct the spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, and behind shelves and drawers. For **Silverfish**, spray bookcases. For **Ants**, spray trails, nests and points of entry.

To Control Carpet Beetles: Spray edges of carpet and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and infested areas of shelving.

To Control Fleas (adults and larvae) and Ticks (adults and larvae), including ticks that may transmit Lyme Disease: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks-and-crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and entire areas of floor and floor covering. Place fresh bedding in animal quarters following treatment. Allow to thoroughly dry before allowing pets to contact treated areas.

To Kill Lice and Louse Eggs: Spray an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration; inspect after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Spray from a distance of 8-10 inches. Treat only those

garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture, that cannot be either laundered or dry-cleaned. Allow all treated articles to thoroughly dry before use.

Outdoor Applications

To control Ticks, including Ticks that may carry Lyme disease (Perimeter Treatment): Use Landlord's Multipurpose 0.5% Liquid Formula [this product] as a residual treatment to control Ticks including the American Dog Tick (*Dermacentor variabilis*), Brown Dog Tick (*Rhipicephalus sanguineus*), Deer Tick (*Ixodes scapularis*), Lone Star Tick, (*Amblyomma americanum*) and Western Black-legged Tick (*Ixodes pacificus*). For each area listed below, apply until surface is wet (approximately 1 gallon per 750 to 1000 square feet). Treat around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces where these pests may enter. Treat a band of vegetation and leaf litter 6-10 feet wide around the outside of buildings to help control Ticks occurring there. To help control Ticks in outdoor activity areas, treat a band of vegetation and leaf litter 6-10 feet wide and adjacent to activity areas, especially where dense vegetation occurs.

For Control of Ornamental Garden Insects

Not for use on plants grown for sale or the commercial research purposes, not for use in commercial greenhouses, nurseries, on sod farms or grass grown for seed.

For the control of Garden Insects: To kill Aphids, Armyworms, Clover Mites, Exposed Thrips, Japanese Beetles, Lace Bugs, Leafminers, Pavement Ants, Red Mites, Spiders, Spider Mites and Whiteflies: Using a sweeping motion from a distance of at least 18 inches, directly spray insects whenever possible on African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, crassula, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuchsia, geraniums, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews, zinnias and other ornamentals. Spray in 1 second bursts and be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Over-application may cause damage. Do not spray plants when temperature exceeds 90°F (32°C). Reapply if reinfestation occurs, but not more than once every 2 weeks. Spray may be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens, and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading to large garden areas.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area away from children and pets.

Pesticide/Container Disposal: Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down an indoor or outdoor drain.
