- 1) Move the Directions For Use section to page 4, the Storage and Disposal instructions must appear grouped together, preferably blocked, near the beginning or the end of the Directions for Use section (40 CFR 156.10(20(x) (MLD-11). It is preferred that the storage and disposal instructions appear at the end of the use Directions section.
- 2) Revise the First Aid Statement to read "Have the product with you when calling a Poison Control or Doctor or going for treatment". In case of emergency, for additional information call (insert toll free-emergency number).
 - EPA encourages registrants to include a company telephone number or toll-free hotline number on their pesticide labels in case of emergency.
- 3) The company name and address must be on the pesticide label. The name and address must be that of the manufacturer, preceded by the phrase "Manufactured by ..." If you are not the manufacturer (producer), the name and address must be qualified by the phrase "Manufactured for..." to indicate that the name shown is not the producer. The name and address must be displayed prominently and within the range of type size that is required for all label text. The name and address may be placed anywhere on the label, but is referred on the front panel.

- 5) The language "apply liberally" and "Re-apply as necessary" will need to be revised to read "apply monthly."
