



### Shake Well

Remove cap to expose tip. Then snip off a portion of the tip as shown in picture No. 1, so that powder will flow freely. **Black Jack Boric Acid Powder Roach Killer** [This product] can be applied quicker by removing the cap as shown in picture No. 2, so that the powder will flow liberally.



To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish, apply monthly, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into opening around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits; and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom drawers and chests of drawers and then scatter liberally in drawer walls.
