The above noted submission to upgrade the label of the subject product has been reviewed and the following comments apply.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before you release the product for shipment.

1. In the First Aid section, revise the "If swallowed" statement to read: "If swallowed promptly drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately."

2. In the Storage & Disposal section, add the sentence "Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility." to the "Disposal" paragraph.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this labeling.
Poly-Algazine 30-35 is a fast acting and effectively kill most types of algae found. It is compatible with those chemicals normally acid and alkaline pH. It can be used in place intended as a substitute for chlorine sanitizer concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
1. Shake well before using.
2. Use the dosage appropriate for your application.
Initial treatment of a freshly filled pool: Add 8 to 12 fluid ounces of Poly-Algazine 30-35 to 10,000 gallons of water.
Initial treatment of a pool with visible algae: Add 16 to 24 fluid ounces of Poly-Algazine 30-35 to 10,000 gallons of water. Then remove by vacuum. Pool floor should be cleaned prior to treatment.
Maintenance dose: Subsequent applications of Poly-Algazine 30-35 for every 10,000 gallons of water. The initial treatment to keep your pool clear.
3. Mix the required amount per dosage in a sprayer or sprinkling can.
4. Distribute the mixed solution or concentrate in a container that will be carefully to avoid swimmers, in particular, children.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and clear water. All pesticide should be kept from children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers. Dispose in trash.
