DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WHEN ALGAE IS NOT VISIBLE: In freshly filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth and for maintenance dosage, add ALGAE-STOP according to the maintenance chart below.

POOL CAPACITY	MAINTENANCE DOSAGE ADD EVERY 3 DAYS
780 gal.	2 oz.
1,560 gal.	4 oz.
3,120 gal.	8 oz.
6,240 gal.	16 oz.

WHEN ALGAE IS VISIBLE: If algae growth is visible, add 1 1/4 gallons ALGAE-STOP per 12,500 gallons of water to kill and control algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. If algae growth is just visible, the initial dose must be 1 1/4 gallons per 12,500 gallons, followed by cleaning out settled algae and applying ALGAE-STOP as stated in maintenance dosage.

IF WARM WEATHER prevails or pool has unusually heavy use, maintenance dosage may have to be repeated more frequently.

HOW TO USE

Mix required amount of ALGAE-STOP into a bucket of water and distribute evenly throughout pool water.
