Dear Mr. Wichy:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes given below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Change the Environmental Hazards section to read:

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water (except when applied for mosquito larvae control; then only around the borders of these areas and in shallow water.) Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment washwaters. Consult your State Fish and Game Agency before applying this product.

2. The statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" must appear directly under the heading "Directions for Use."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The Confidential Statements of Formula (CSFs) are not acceptable. The EPA Registration Number for this product is 8898-16. However, you have indicated that the Registration Number of the source of the active ingredient, Aliphatic Petroleum Hydrocarbon, is 8898-16. A component of a formulation cannot have the same Registration Number as the formulation itself. Please identify the source of the active ingredient.

Note that GB-1111 is an accepted additional brand name for this product. Product bearing this additional brand name must have the same formulation as the basic product and you need not submit an additional CSF for it.

You have also submitted a CSF with an alternate formulation for use when GB-1356 is used as the brand name. This CSF is further unacceptable because of the addition of 9-octadecen-1-amine. As we stated in the Agency letter dated April 8, 1987, aliphatic amines must be declared as active ingredients. (Long-chain beta-amines have larvicidal activity against some mosquito species, particularly when chain length reaches 15 carbons.) You may not have an alternate formulation that includes an additional active ingredient.

We have previously accepted GB-1356 as an additional brand name for this product. You may continue to use this additional brand name, but only on products with the same formulation as is used for GB-1313 and GB-1111.

If you wish to market a product containing 9-octadecen-1-amine, you may submit an application for registration of a new product.
