HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS!

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, skin, or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear such as goggles, safety glasses, or face shield. Wear chemical resistant gloves, long sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and shoes. Do not breathe dust, vapor, or spray mist. - polyurethane;
- adhesives, caulking compounds, paint (oil and latex), latex, sealants and tile grout;
- metal working cutting fluids;
- hard non-porous surfaces;
- garbage containers and bed pans; and
- ropes, carpets, textiles, canvas products, and fabric surfaces (including upholstery).

For formulating micro-biocides, fungicides and algacides used in water systems such as for refrigeration equipment, poultry and livestock water equipment, animal feeding and watering equipment, industrial processing equipment, hatchery equipment, evaporative condensers, heat exchangers, secondary oil recovery systems, brewery pasteurizers, pulp and paper mills, and cooling towers.

This product may not be used to formulate antifouling coatings or antifouling paints.

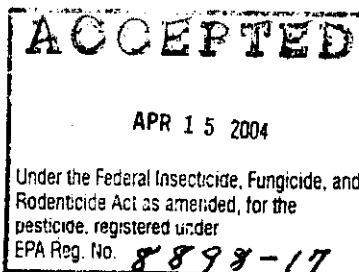
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
