## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

KOCIDE 20/20 should be used as described below. KOCIDE 20/20 is adaptable to spraying from all types of spray equipment. Depending on the equipment used, the volume applied per acre will differ.

No additional surfactants are needed. Add KOCIDE 20/20 slowly to a spray tank partially filled with water. Spreader-stickers, insecticides, etc. should be added last.
