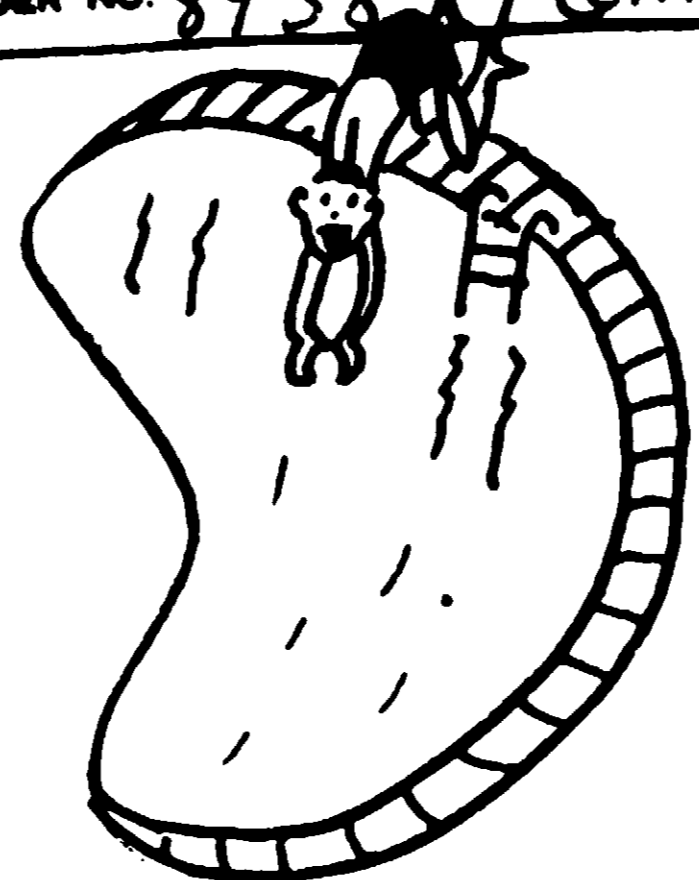

DIRECTIONS for USE & DILUTION

The best results are obtained when pool is cleaned and filled with fresh water. One gallon of SPAC Algaecide treats 50,000 gallons, then maintenance dose one quart every 5 to 7 days. (1 oz. SPAC to 400 gals.) For small pools 2 tablespoonfuls to 200 gals. water, then 1/2 tablespoonful every 5 to 7 days. When algae are observed add 77 ozs. per 7,500 gals. The follow up dose after Vacuuming and refilling should be 20 ozs. per 7,500 gals., then the maintenance dose every 5 to 7 days of 5 ozs. Pour solution into various locations, it will soon distribute itself.
