**FEEDING DIRECTION:** Feed 1/2 lb. of Bar-By Beef Cattle Pasture Feed Block Medicated per day to each 1,000 lbs. of body weight of cattle fed continuously as the sole source of feed. Adjust the cattle's consumption rate carefully to assure they are consuming the product at the recommended rate per day. Use 1 block for each 1,000 lbs. of cattle's body weight supply at all times for adequate protection. Water must be near the animals' water supply or loafing area. Phenothiazine is effective against existing adult flies. Since it is not effective against early summer and feed Bar-By Beef Cattle Pasture Feed Block Medication on a year round basis. Since face flies may fly from farm to farm, it is essential that the larvicide remain effective throughout the season to assist in reduction of adult populations. Consult veterinarian before using in severely debilitated cattle.
