



VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: Use 16 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

PREVENTION OF ALGAE: 8 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water once every two weeks.

APPLICATION: This product comes concentrated. Dilute with at least nine parts of water before applying. Pour required amount of this product into a watering can and fill with water. Maintaining continuous pool circulation, sprinkle solution around edge of pool. Apply under sunny conditions for most effective results.

TO CONTROL BLACK ALGAE: Use a black algaecide product as directed on the product's label. Once control is obtained, resume regular algaestatic maintenance with this product.

INITIAL POOL START-UP - Use a sequestering agent to prevent scale and stain formation.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Always apply chemicals separately. Never combine them.

TO ESTIMATE POOL CAPACITY

Square or Rectangular Pools - $L \times W \times D \times 7.5 =$ Gallons

Circular or Elliptical Pools = $L \times W \times D \times 5.9 =$ Gallons

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: This product may cause skin damage. Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing. This product may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals. Harmful if swallowed. If swallowed call a doctor.

FIRST AID:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in original container in cool, dry place. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly, wrap container and put in trash collection.
