The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. On the front panel delete the term OTHER INGREDIENTS ~~_____~~
~~_____~~ The inert ingredients percentages must be changed accordingly.
 - b. On the front panel the signal word DANGER must be in slightly larger type size.
 - c. On the side panel directly under DIRECTIONS FOR USE add the following misuse statement:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 - d. On the right panel delete the term sanitizer in the sixth line under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE.
 - e. On the right panel add "that is found on inanimate hard surfaces" after ". . . of athletes foot."


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2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
