The above noted submission, revised labeling for the subject product, has been reviewed and the following comments apply.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before you release the product for shipment.

1. Expand your precautionary statements on the right panel of the label by adding the statement: "In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists."

2. Revise the "First Aid" statement to read: "If swallowed drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately."

3. Expand your "Disposal" statement to read: "Do not reuse empty container. When empty rinse container thoroughly, wrap container and place in trash."

INITIAL TREATMENT: For visible algae growth or slimy surface, add 6-8 fl. ozs. of ALGAECIDE per 500 gals. For maximum effectiveness, spas containing heavy algae should be drained and cleaned prior to treatment.

MAINTENANCE: After initial treatment, to keep your spa free of algae growth, add 1-2 fl. oz. per 500 gals. capacity every 7 days.

ALGAECIDE is compatible with other spa chemicals. When used in conjunction with chlorine or bromine chemicals, reduce the amount of those chemicals required.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Always apply chemicals separately. Do not combine them.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION
Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.
