DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL TREATMENT: For visible algae growth or slimy interior surface, add 6-8 fl. oz. of This product per 500 gals. capacity. For maximum effectiveness, spas containing heavy growth of algae should be drained and cleaned prior to treatment.

MAINTENANCE: After initial treatment, to keep your spa free of algae growth, add 1-2 fl. oz. per 500 gals. capacity every 5-7 days.

This product is compatible with other spa chemicals. It can be used in conjunction with chlorine or bromine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals required.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Always apply chemicals separately. Never combine them.
