Attached is a notification to submit the changes required in the comments paragraph of the approved label of the approved label for the referenced product. The comments required us to delete parts of the Storage and Disposal language we had submitted and replace it with a statement to "Wrap container and put in trash ...". In reviewing the changes and options available I found that in PR Notice 2007-1 the Wrap container language was no longer allowed. I called and talked to Tracy about it and it was decided to keep the language that was on the label, that being the language required in PR Notice 2007-4.

We would therefore ask that you accept the Nonrefillable container – household/residential use language as appears on our originally submitted label In support of this notification, enclosed you will find the following:

This product works best when added [in several places] by itself directly to spa or hot tub water with the pump running. Wait 15 minutes before entry of swimmers. Spas or hot tubs with heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INITIAL TREATMENT: For visible algae growth or slimy interior, add 6-8 ounces of this product for every 500 gallons of spa water. For best results, spas containing heavy algae growth should be drained and cleaned prior to treatment.

MAINTENANCE: After the initial treatment, keep your spa free of algae growth by adding 1-2 ounces for every 500 gallons of spa water every 5-7 days. This product is compatible with other spa chemicals. It can be used in conjunction with chlorine or bromine and may geduce the amount of those chemicals required. CCCCC
