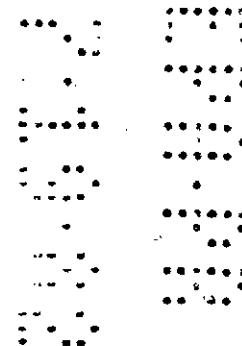

PORTATRINE

PORTATRINE is specially formulated to prevent odors and allow easy dumping of portable and recirculating toilets. PORTATRINE kills odor-causing bacteria, emulsifies wastes, removes and prevents stains and scale, reduces foaming, and leaves a pleasant fragrance.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

RECIRCULATING TOILETS:

Charge toilet with manufacturer's recommended amount of water. Pour 1 oz. of PORTATRINE per gallon (8 ml/liter) of toilet capacity directly into the toilet bowl. Recirculate 10-15 seconds to mix PORTATRINE and water.

PORTABLE TOILETS:

Pour 1 oz. of PORTATRINE per gallon (8 ml/liter) of holding tank capacity directly into the tank. Add enough water to cover the tank bottom. When toilet is not used, add 2 oz. (60 ml) of PORTATRINE and 1 cup (250 ml) of water to holding tank to keep it fresh smelling.

CLEANING TOILETS:

To deodorize and clean units with caked on waste, put 1 oz. of PORTATRINE per gallon (8 ml/liter) of charge water (recirculating systems) or tank capacity (portable toilets). Fill system with water, let stand 24 to 48 hours and dump. For recirculating systems, recirculate 10 to 15 seconds each hour for several hours and then dump.

DANGER

- j. Revise the statement: (upper page 2)

"...portatrine kills odor-causing bacteria..."

to read:

"...portatrine inhibits the growth of odor-causing bacteria..."

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the 4-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

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If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
